The District should still inform parents of close contacts but allow parents to make the decision on the quarantining of their children, who are showing no symptoms or are asymptomatic. Williamsburg Community School District will notify other districts of close contacts that will be participating in extracurricular activities. We agree that someone who brings to the school's attention a positive COVID case, that individual should be quarantined. This procedure is effective immediately. Seconded by Joe Detwiler.
